Location

Our Discovery, Explorer and Adventure programs are conducted at Brace Park, 2800 Haven Way at Scott Road, Burbank. Our Voyager program is conducted at our Child Development Center at 332 E. San Jose Ave, Burbank.

Hours

Camp activity hours are Monday through Friday, 9:00am-4:00pm unless otherwise posted. Children may arrive at camp beginning at 7:00am and should arrive no later than the posted times. Any child picked up after 6:30pm will be charged a late fee.

Enrollment

We encourage people to enroll early, as our camps fill up very quickly and our policy is "first come, first served." You can enroll online beginning March 8. Our website is www.burbankymca.org. Click onto the Summer Day Camp page. All pertinent information will be online. You can download all the necessary camp forms and fill it out at your leisure.

Once you choose which weeks of camp your child will be enrolled in, you can secure your child's place in camp by using a credit card. You MUST pay the one-time only non-refundable \$50 enrollment fee, as well as the weekly deposits. If you wish, you may pay in full for all the weeks of camp.

To complete your online enrollment, all signed paperwork must be turned in to the Child Development Center during regular business hours 8:00am-5:00pm, any time after March 8.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Families who participate in the Child Care Resource Center (CCRC) program or use the Burbank Community YMCA financial scholarship program may not register online. They are required to bring all approval documentation to the Burbank Community YMCA Child Development Center prior to registration. If the approval documentation is not presented at this time, parents are responsible for all program fees. If you enroll online and are expecting a sibling discount, please note that the discount will be applied to the balance due.

Enrollment Fee

A one-time \$50 non-refundable enrollment fee is required for each child. This fee covers enrollment processing and equipment. This does not include a YMCA Membership for the enrollment period.

Payments and Deposits

A \$40 per week, non-refundable deposit is required to reserve a space in a day camp week. This deposit guarantees your child's space only until the payment due date as indicated below. If payment is not received by the due date, the deposit is forfeited and the space is open to those on our waiting list. **A \$25 late processing fee will be applied for all payments and registrations not received 2 weeks prior to a camp session.**

Refunds

Program fees (excluding the \$40 per week deposit) are refunded or credited if you request in writing at least two weeks before the first day of a camp week.

Payment Options

For your convenience, all payment transactions are done electronically by drafting a bank account or credit card. We accept Visa, MasterCard or American Express.

Camp Requirements

All campers must wear a 2010 YMCA Summer Day Camp T-shirt every day they attend camp. We require that all campers wear their official shirts to ensure the optimum level of identification, supervision and safety. This policy is strictly enforced! Camp T-shirts are \$10 and may be picked up at Parent Orientation or at our Child Development Center, Monday-Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm. Parents are also required to provide a daily lunch, morning and afternoon snacks and sunscreen. **Please note that we are a nut-free facility. Pick up your shirts on or before Parent Orientation night to receive a free YMCA camp shirt per child!**

Sibling Discounts

Program fee discounts of \$10 per week are given for additional children enrolled in the same week.

Financial Scholarships

Application forms for financial assistance are available after March 8 at our Child Development Center, Monday-Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm or on our website at www.burbankymca.org. Scholarships are awarded on a "first come, first served" basis.

Insurance

The YMCA does not carry accident insurance on its members or participants. Coverage is the responsibility of the participant.

Program Changes and Cancellations

The YMCA reserves the right to cancel any program, substitute staff and change trip schedules. Refunds are provided only for program cancellations as referenced in the Refund section. Please refer to the Parent Handbook for additional cancellation information.

The CIT program is designed to train prospective staff members for employment at the Burbank Community YMCA's Summer Day Camp. It also gives high school students a behind-the-scenes look at camp life and highlights what it is really like to be a camp counselor. Participants will also gain valuable volunteer service in their community. The experience looks great on college applications. And it's an impressive addition to resumes for those who are immediately looking to join the work force upon high school graduation. CITs must commit to a minimum of three weeks during our camp season which runs from June-August. Participants will "job shadow" trained counselors and help with the supervision of campers.
