CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER (CDC) PROGRAMS

Our Preschool program is for children between the ages of 18 months and five years old. It is separated into the Toddler program (18-30 months) and the Preschool program (2 ½ years through Pre-Kindergarten).

Our School Age program is for children and youth from Kindergarten through 8th grade.

HOURS

The Preschool program operates Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 6:00pm.

The School Age program operates Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 6:30pm.

CDC Office operates Monday-Friday from 8:00am-5:00pm

CURRICULUM

Our Preschool curriculum is play-based and child-centered with a strong emphasis on developmentally appropriate practices. Teachers use *Creative Curriculum* as a framework to create a learning experience that promotes social, emotional, physical, language, and cognitive development. The classrooms are warm, inviting and divided into different learning areas: Math/Manipulatives, Art, Literacy, Blocks, and Science. Every classroom has a schedule that includes circle time, small group work, child choice in learning areas, and outdoor activities. Each child has a portfolio to document their individual growth and development. Promoting good health and nutrition is an important foundation for a healthy life. We provide nutritionally based snacks in the morning and in the afternoon and parents provide their child's lunch. The CDC is a *Nut Free* Facility.

The goal of our program is to plan and implement a comprehensive program for the children that integrate the best concepts of early childhood. We try to help children develop a sense of security based on an awareness that they belong, in their own way, to their family, their group, their school, and their community. We work to establish and maintain a collaborative partnership with each child's family through daily communication with teachers, weekly classroom letters, twice yearly family conferences, social gatherings, and special events.

Our School Age curriculum focuses on your child's physical, emotional, cognitive, and social well-being. We plan age appropriate activities such as homework, arts and crafts, outdoor games, sports, science, free choice time, and special interest clubs such as theatre and cooking. Our clubs and themes are designed to fit the needs and interests of all the children.

The CDC provides a safe, loving, and stimulating learning environment where children can discover, explore, experiment, and grow at their own pace. Special emphasis is placed on helping the child to develop social
