CHILD WATCH

Because the Burbank Community YMCA knows how challenging it can be for families with small children to get and maintain a workout program, we offer an in-house service, free to members.

Our baby-sitting service is located on the first floor of the Main building. It is for children between the ages of 3 months to 9 years of age.

Our staff is dedicated to creating a safe and secure environment for the children, while their parents use the facility. Children can have stories read to them, play with age appropriate toys, watch kid-friendly videos or even be rocked to sleep.

The Burbank Community YMCA wants to make it as easy as possible for our members with children to get the most out of their membership. Child Watch assures parents that their children are well cared for.

Child Watch Policies

1. Parents must not leave the premises for any reason while the child is under the care of our Child Watch staff.
 2. Children may stay a maximum of two hours at the Child Watch center.
 3. Our Child Watch staff is not required to change diapers; therefore, if your child needs a diaper change, you will be contacted and asked to come to the Child Watch center.
 4. Parents must sign their child in and out, using our sign-up sheets and must use the name tags that are provided.
 5. All food and drinks must be provided by the parent and must be labeled with their names.
 6. Our ratio is 10 children per sitter. Due to this rule, the service is available on a first come, first serve basis. The maximum is 20 children. A wait list will be available.
 7. In consideration of our staff and the other children, please do not bring your child to the YMCA if he or she is ill.
